

#### **Background**

Bangladesh Association, Houston (BAH) was established in 1978 as a non-profit organization in the State of Texas and was granted the Internal Revenue Service Tax exempted 501(c)(3) status in May of 1985. This non-profit organization is managed and operated by an elected, but volunteer Board of Directors. The Bangladesh American Center (BAC) is a project of BAH, which is located at 13415 Renn Road, Houston, TX 77083.

Bagladesh American Center (BAC) is designed to be a multipurpose community center. The vision of BAC is to unite people of Bangladeshi origin in North America by providing a permanent physical location to display, demonstrate, share, and represent Bangladeshi culture and heritage. This will be a place where ideas can be shared and exchanged to promote and increase understanding of diversity and peaceful integration, pursue and achieve common goals, within the framework of Bangladesh Association of Houston (BAH) constitution. Currently BAH contributes to the community enrichment by providing Bangla language education, hosting cultural festivals, and by providing medical services for the needy. The Center is an aspiration of the community to enrich the cultural experience for the Bangladeshi-American, but more so for future generations of Americans with or without Bangladeshi heritage.

The mission of Bangladesh-American Center is to facilitate social, cultural, intellectual, and educational activities of the Bangladesh-American Community, involving the Bangladeshi Americans or any other groups generally interested in promoting BAC vision and core values.

BAC would host local and national community leaders to promote public causes and broaden awareness on various issues impacting the local, national, and international communities. It could also be a venue for many to volunteer and provide paralegal assistance in immigration and other legal matters, social security and government services, as well as host many traditional community gatherings for various occasions.

The Center will be the first of its kind in many ways: the first community center to be erected by Bangladeshis in America, in a city synonymous with venturing towards the future, and built by the people and for the people of all backgrounds.

## Bangladesh American Center Complex is truly a symbol of unity and community pride.

#### **Mission Statement**

The mission of BAC is to facilitate social, cultural, intellectual, and educational activities of the Bangladeshi-American Community, involving the Bangladeshi Americans or any other groups generally interested in promoting BAC vision and core values, as well as to preserve, stimulate and promote respect for cultural diversity and intercultural values.

#### **Vision Statement**

The vision of BAC is to unite the people of Bangladeshi origin in North America by providing a permanent physical location to display, demonstrate and represent Bangladeshi culture and heritage. BAC will also provide physical facilities where ideas can be shared and exchanged to promote and increase understanding of diversity and peaceful integration; pursue and achieve common goals within the framework of BAH constitution.

#### **Core Values**

- BAC shall be open to all freedom loving people
- BAC shall promote and uphold the culture, heritage, and values of Bangladesh in North America
- BAC shall to preserve, stimulate and promote respect for cultural diversity and intercultural values
- BAC shall uphold the values stated in the BAH constitution
- BAC shall maintain true transparency in all of its financial accounts
- BAC shall be governed by a democratic process; where the majority shall rule but the difference of opinions will be respected
- BAC shall remain non-political and secular
- BAC shall not allow any fundamentalism, cult, or fanaticism of any kind.





## Get to know our 2016 Multicultural Gala Chair - Dr. Selina M. Ahmed

Selina Ahmed was born in Bangladesh. In 1973, Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas, conferred upon her a Doctor of Philosophy degree in Human Nutrition.

Since August of 1975, she has taught Nutrition as an Associate Professor at Texas Southern University in the Department of Human Services and Consumer Sciences.

She has also served as an Administrative Clinical Dietitian for Methodist Hospital and as a Research Fellow in the area of Space Nutrition at NASA Johnson Space Center. Dr Ahmed's other community and professional services include serving as President of the Bangladesh Association of Houston and working with former Congressman Mickey Leland to develop a Hunger Relief Program for Bangladesh. Dr. Ahmed has also received several nominations and awards in the Houston Peace Network for the Lifetime Service/Outstanding Local Person at the Fourth Annual Peace and Justice Award Event. She has also received the Texas Southern University National Achievement Award (1993-1994) for her exceptional work in education and humanitarian service, which earned her recognition from former Texas Governor Ann Richards and former Houston Mayor Bob Lanier.

Selina Ahmed served as the Interim Director of the Mickey Leland Center on World Hunger and Peace at Texas Southern University for four years and she is on the advisory board of the institute of International Education, Houston Area Model United Nations and Planned Parenthood. She founded the Annual Childhood Obesity Conference in the Human Services and Consumer Services department at Texas Southern University 12 years ago. She currently serves on the board for the Asia Society Texas Center. In this capacity, she continues her work to serve the community through education about issues of hunger, peace and refugees. She is also a board member with Kid-Care, an organization that provides meals for underprivileged children. She has worked to bring world leaders in the peace movement to Texas Southern University and Houston, such as the Dalai Lama and Dr. Nafis Sadik. Dr. Ahmed hopes to educate her community and the world about hunger and peace issues, and she dedicates her life to finding solutions to the problems of hunger, homelessness and inadequate health care.

Along with her accomplishments, as a community leader, program consultant, professor and a researcher, the most noted and awarding of all, has been the international fare and ethnicity given to foods for future long Duration Missions in Space.

Dr. Selina M. Ahmed is currently serving as the Interim Chair of Department of Human Services and Consumer Sciences at the Texas Southern and a Philanthropist. D-Mars Business Journal recognized Dr. Ahmed as one of the Top 30 Influential Women of Houston. Tenacity, discipline and diligence are just a few of the criteria for making the list. 2015 honorees have broken barriers in their respective fields and left an indelible mark on the face of Houston.

Ms. Beverly Denver of Houston Woman Magazine recognized her as the 50 Most influential Woman of Houston 2015.

Dear Members of the Bangladesh Association, Dearest Bengali Sisters and Brothers,

The peoples of Turkey and Bangladesh have been enjoying brotherly relations even before the foundation of both states. The Muslims of South Asia including our Bengali sisters and brothers had supported the Turkish War of Independence in 1919, which was reflected in the "Kamal Pasha" poem, written by the National Poet of Bangladesh, Kazi Nazrul İslam, hailing the founder of the Republic of Turkey, Mustafa Kemal Atatürk. The support of the Bengal people during the Turkish War of Independence is still remembered with gratitude by the Turkish people.

Turkey, on the other hand, recognized Bangladesh on February 22nd, 1974 shortly after its declaration of independence and the Turkish Embassy in Dhaka was opened in 1976 while the Embassy of Bangladesh in Ankara started in 1981.

Turkey and Bangladesh are two friendly states in close cooperation at several international platforms, the United Nations (UN) and the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) in particular.

Turkish direct investment in Bangladesh has reached 8,16 Billion USD in 2015 according to the data released by Bangladeshi Central Bank. There are almost 100 Turkish companies working in the sectors such as textiles, ready-made garment, carpet production, education and programming.

Official Development Aid given by Turkey to Bangladesh between the years of 2004-2014 amounts to 13 million USD. The important part of the money is used for education, health, and vocational projects. Turkish Cooperation and Coordination Agency (TIKA) established a "Program Coordination Office" in Bangladesh in 2014 to better plan and coordinate its aid activities in the country.

Turkish Airlines is connecting Dhaka and Houston with its daily direct flights between Istanbul-Dhaka and Istanbul-Houston and provides the opportunity to advance the already strong economic and cultural ties.

The peoples of Bangladesh and Turkey enjoy a strong foundation on which we can further develop our relations. As the Consul General of the Republic of Turkey in Houston, I salute my Bengali sisters and brothers and looking forward to continue to explore ways to further develop our relations.

## **4** SPORTS


Healthy lifestyle and sports are tied together. To promote healthy and active lifestyle our community center will provide multitude of services. Kids soccer, tennis, basketball,
